Key Concepts:

1) Shedding of leaves

2) Compost pit

Learning Outcomes:

The students:

- Know that the trees shed the leaves in certain seasons.
- Understand that the surroundings become dirty with the fallen dry leaves.
- Know that the surroundings should be swept cleanly when the dried leaves fall on the ground.
- Understand that when the leaves are burnt the air gets polluted.
- Know that the dried leaves should be thrown in to compost pit. After a few days, they become a good fertilizer.

Conceptual Understanding:

The trees shed the leaves in certain seasons. The surroundings become dirty with these fallen dry leaves. So, these should be swept and thrown in to the compost pit from time to time. Later the pit should be covered with soil. After a few days, they become a good fertilizer.
